When, how and where do you choose your area rugs?

We choose our floor covering at the start of a project, because at Inhabit we feel flooring is the foundation of the design. Our initial search begins online and in our catalogs, but it is essential to see the rug or a sample to ensure that the color and quality are in line with our project.

Inhabit Design is located just a few blocks from the World Market Center in downtown Las Vegas, so it is very easy for us to stop by our local showrooms like Safavieh, Capel and Momeni. We work with Polar Carpets for custom area rugs. We attend the Las Vegas market twice a year.

Do you have a favorite style of rug?

I am loving the look of layered animal skins right now. They have a great organic shape and fabulous texture.
